

MESSAGE FROM YOUR DCM

Dear Friends!



Our 69th Anniversary via Zoom was a success! We had approximately 20 people online to hear Barb D. share her experience, strength and hope. I recorded her (audio only, on account of our tradition of anonymity), and will look to see how I can make this available. Her story is one familiar to many of us, and demonstrates that we can stay sober no matter what by giving back what we have so freely been given. Newly sober, she quickly got into service work beyond the coffee pot, at district level and then at the Virginia Area, where she was voted in as our delegate to the 69th General Service Conference (a number which she delighted to tell us matched our years of AA in Manassas!). There are no coincidences. It is a message that I have been writing

about over these last 22 months - and this month is no different!!

November is also gratitude month. If you look to February 24 in the "Reflections" book, the writer talks about an "attitude of gratitude." I wrote about that previously in one of my missives – you can look it up for further details. Per our seventh tradition, fellowship members have been generous in giving money during this time of COVID restrictions to our service bodies. GSO continues to operate, even though no one goes to the office except to pick up mail. VAC also continues to operate in an online environment. Much less travel has brought some costs down, but there are still some operational costs to making sure that "we" carry the message of AA and that it will be available for the alcoholic who is still to find their way into our rooms.

Even when restrictions are lifted, many of us will be grateful to rejoin in-person meetings. Yet, I believe that since we have made this venture into enforced online meeting environments, it will provide a way for people who cannot get out due to health limitations or who have trouble traveling an opportunity to participate as never before.
