





Alcohol Anonymous can replace the Hideous Four Horsemen with Faith, Hope, Gratitude, Desire.

- Faith: complete trust or confidence in something.
- Hope: a feeling of expectation.
- Gratitude: the quality of being thankful.
- Desire: a strong feeling of wanting to have something.

In the AA rooms, we hear stories about how one day we wake up with the Hideous Four Horseman's outlook of our place in life, AKA the "gift of desperation." And how working the program helps us change. The Four Horsemen leave, and the hideous feelings are replaced with Faith, Hope, Gratitude, and Desire. Sometimes quickly, sometimes slowly, new feelings of Faith, Hope, Gratitude, and Desire materialize if we work the program. That was the case for me and countless others.



It takes an attitude that we will not let the ordinary ups and downs of life drive us crazy...that it's OK to laugh over them because we have been given the gift of sobriety.


Look for the humor by accepting, having faith, and then not taking things so seriously.
