Types of Service in Recovery

Anything that directly or indirectly helps others in recovery could be considered service. Examples of this type of work include the following:

- Sponsorship
- Intergroup Representative
- [General Service Representative](#)
- Volunteering to work with homeless AAs
- Visiting AAs in prison
- Making coffee or tea at a AA meeting
- Chairing or moderating at a A.A. meeting
- Giving out coins / tokens/ chips
- Meeting set-up or clean-up
- Welcoming newcomers to recovery meetings
- Being supportive of those who are struggling in recovery
- Taking an official service role within a recovery group, for example, **treasurer** or **secretary** or **greeter** [my addition]
- Making time to speak to people who are obviously struggling with problems

Those individuals who do not hide their past can prove inspirational for those who are dealing with this type of problem.

Service in recovery benefits both the giver and receiver. In a lot of instances, it will actually be the giver who ends up benefiting the most.
