I retrieved one of the vacuums to be available for use for final cleanup later in the morning. I noticed a gentleman from church (respecting his anonymity we'll call him 'Bill') at a table in one of the back offices - "so now my anonymity is blown..." I had been told by the church staff that 'Bill' might know where our Manassas AA banner had gone. Many of you have seen this – a big old silk banner with fringe that is hung up at many of our celebrations. Anyway, he turned out to be the person who had moved some of our district items from the sunroom to the storage room to make way for the sodas sold out of the refrigerator. In frustration, I had looked high and low in the storage room a couple of times for the banner - it was nowhere to be found. I take a deep breath; "Hi, Bill, I thought you were supposed to be in Missouri!" "Oh, hi, we got back last night and with the new year, I need to close out 2022." At this point he is standing up. I take another deep breath, "I heard you cleaned out the AA stuff in the sunroom for the sodas. I found most of the items, but I couldn't find the banner that was stored in a black plastic garbage bag. I hoped it hadn't been thrown out." He leans down to his left, picks up a black garbage bag, and says, "Is this it?" handing it to me. Looking inside, I check for the handsewn lettering. There it is! I exclaim, "Yes, that's it!" and I reach out and give him a big hug - "Thank you!" He is surprised by that. I explain that it is over 60 years old and was handmade by some of our members.

God moments are forever happening - my New Year's Eve and day celebrations were filled with them. They always make getting out of my comfort zone well worth it!
